Deut. 8:1-5

**Humble yourselves, therefore, under the
mighty hand of God, that He may exalt
you in due time, casting all your care upon
Him, for He cares for you. 1 Pet. 5:6-7**

Humble Yourself to Walk with **God**

Deut. 8:1-5

Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God; but exhort one another daily, while it is called Today, lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end.

Heb. 3:12-14

God walking **with us!**

Exod. 2:23-25 Psa. 31:7 Isa. 63:7-9

Yet I am the Lord your God ever since the land of Egypt, and you shall know no God but Me; For there is no savior besides Me. **I knew you in the wilderness**, in the land of great drought.

Walking with God?

1 Sam. 2:12-17

Now sons of Eli were base men; they **knew not the LORD**... And sin of the young men was very great before the LORD; for the men despised the offering of the LORD.

Walking with God?

Hos. 4:1-2

Hear the word of the Lord, you children of Israel, for the Lord brings a charge against the inhabitants of the land: There is no truth or mercy or knowledge of God in the land. By swearing and lying, killing and stealing and committing adultery, they break all restraint, with bloodshed upon bloodshed.

Walking with God?

Hos. 6:4-6

O Ephraim, what shall I do to you? O Judah, what shall I do to you? For your faithfulness is like a morning cloud, and like the early dew it goes away... For I desire mercy and not sacrifice, and **the knowledge of God** more than burnt offerings.

Walking with God

1 Jn. 1:1-3,5-7

The Life was manifested and we have seen, and bear witness, and declare to you that **Eternal Life** which was with the Father and was manifested to us.

Walking with God

1 Jn. 1:1-3,5-7

God is light and in Him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and **walk in darkness**, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we **walk in the light** as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another...

Walking with God

God comes to **know** us because
He walks with us.

We come to know God when **we**
walk with God.

Walking with God

Jn. 17:20-21

I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that **they also may be one in Us**, that the world may believe that You sent Me.

Walking with God

Jn. 17:23

I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me.
