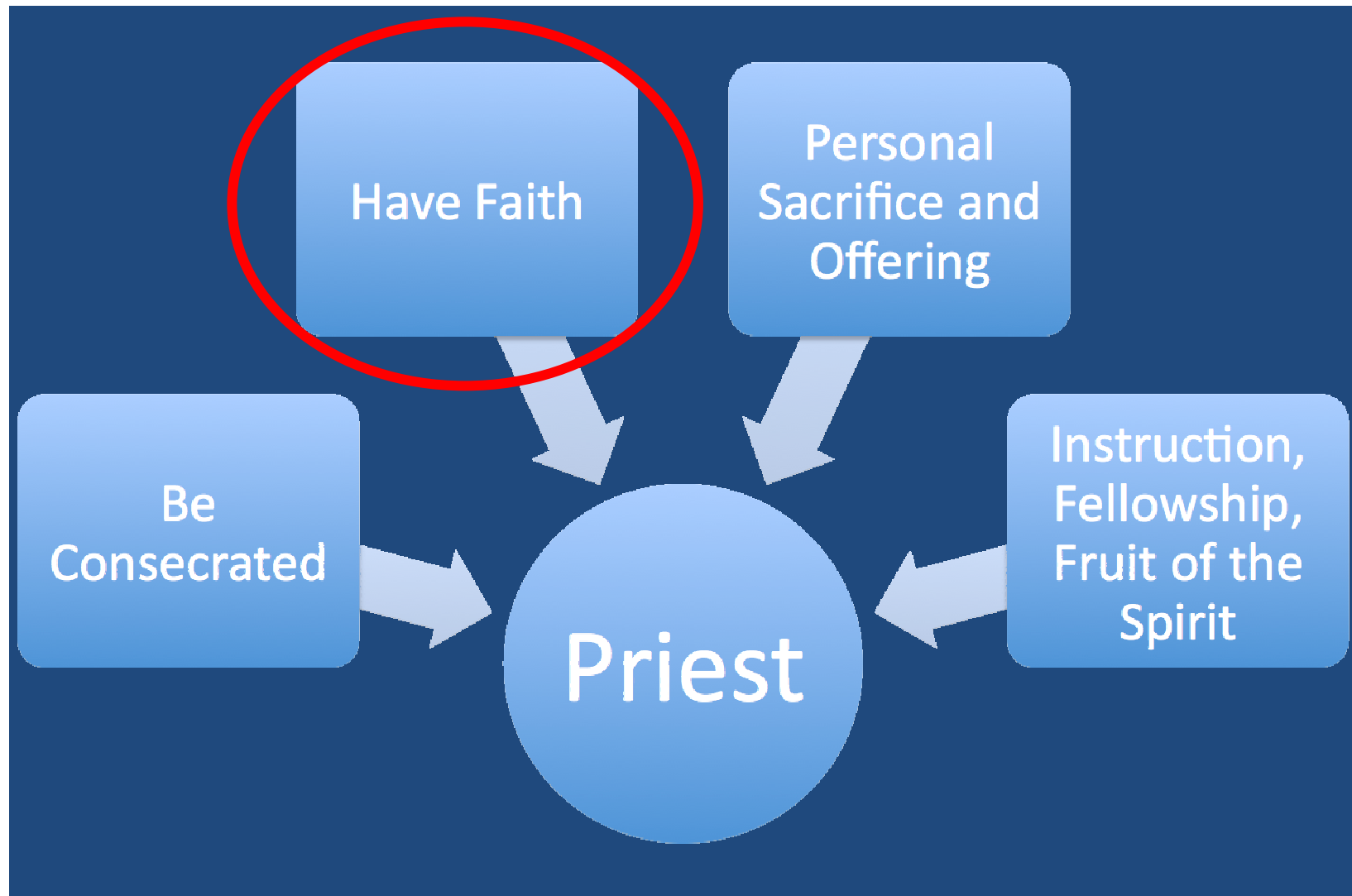

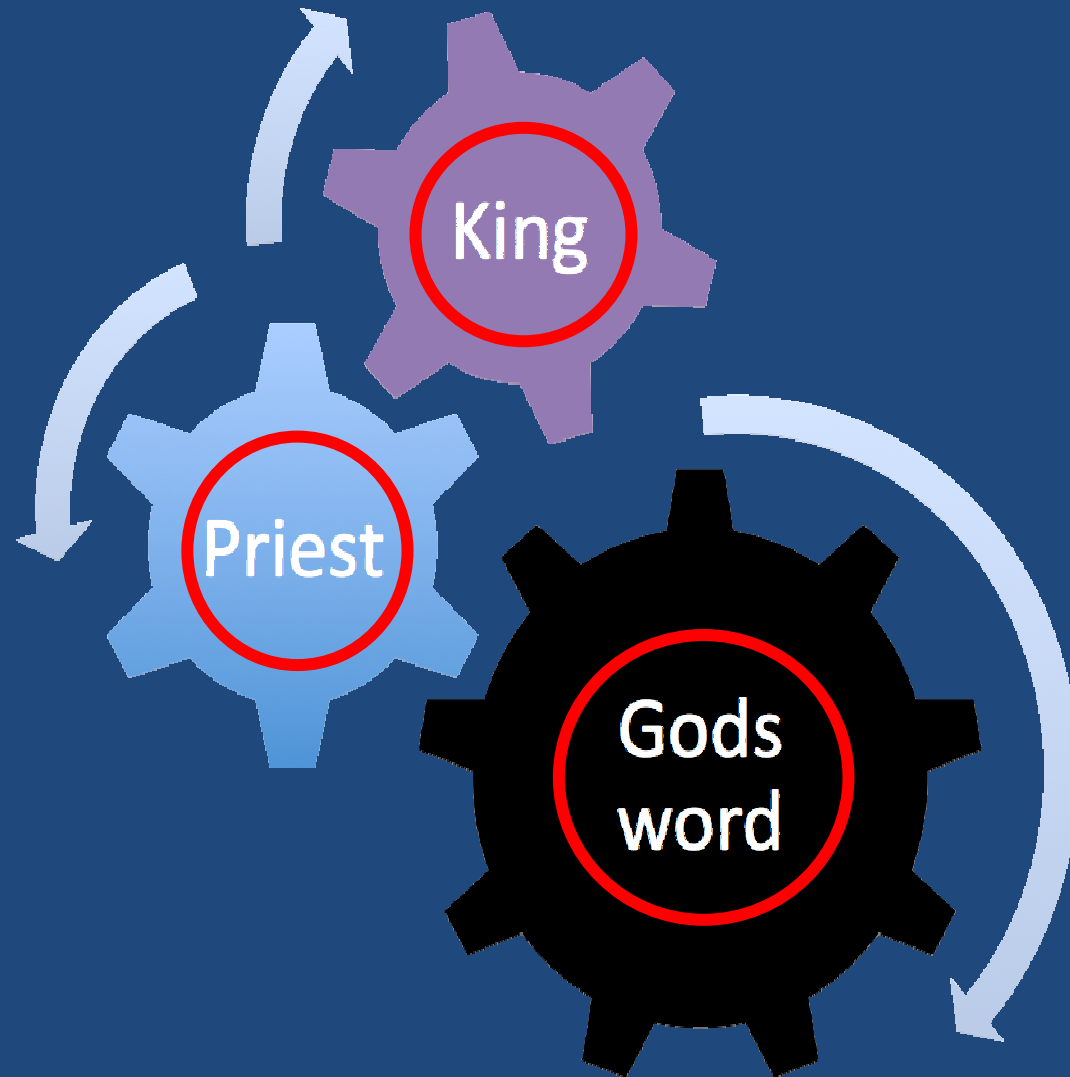

Kingship

- 'monarch' - from Latin 'monarcha'
 - from Greek 'monogenes'
 - from the root 'monos'
 - means 'ONLY'

Kingship

‘monogenes’ - used 9 times in New Testament

All translated ‘only child’

- 5 used by John – exclusively refer to Jesus:

- John 1:14,18

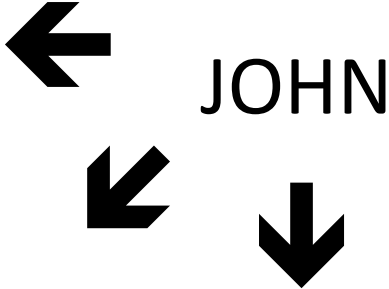
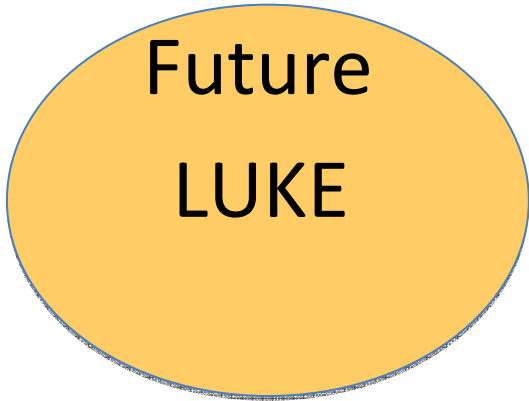
The **only begotten** of the Father full of grace and truth

- John 3:16,18

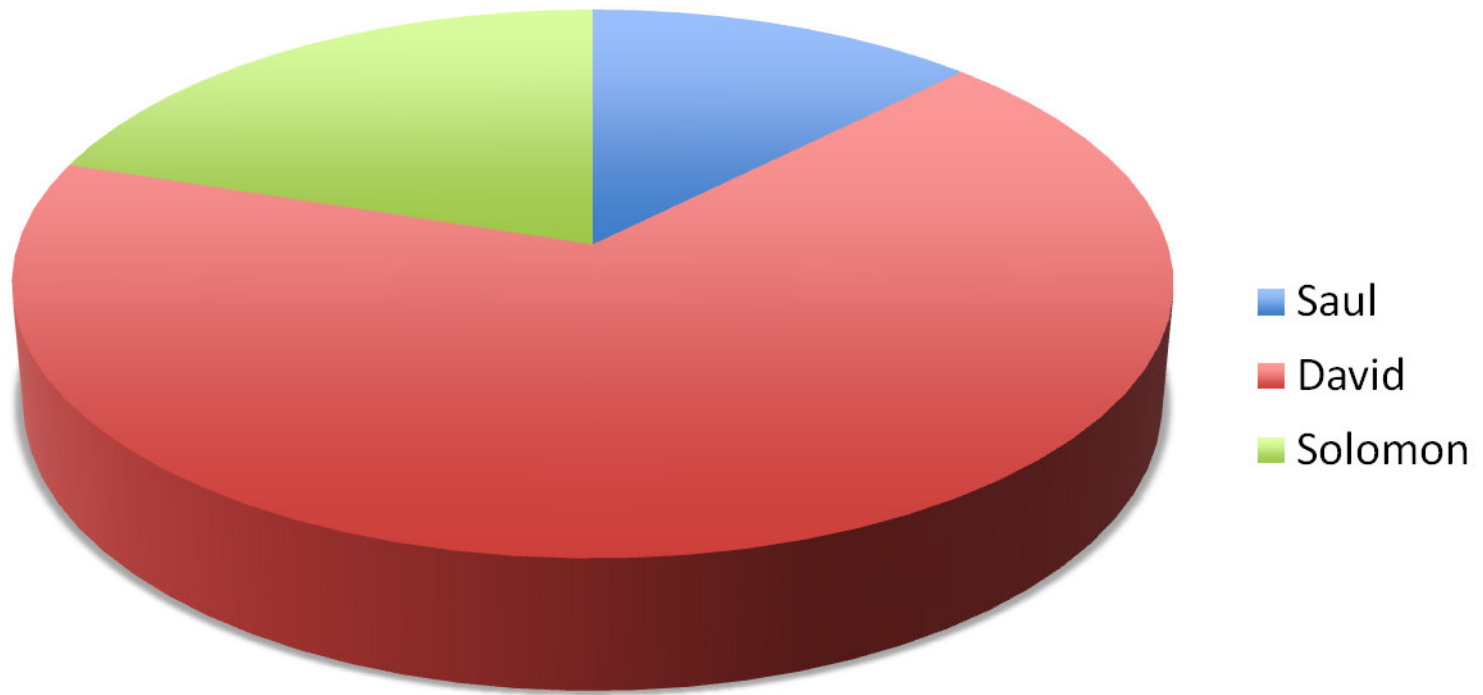
He gave his **only begotten** son

- 1 John 4:9

God sent his **only begotten** son

Our King

- 'Archagos' – Prince, Captain, Author

- Acts 5:31

29 But Peter and the other apostles answered and said: “We ought to obey God rather than men. **30** The God of our fathers raised up Jesus whom you murdered by hanging on a tree. **31** Him God has exalted to His right hand to be **Prince** and Savior, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins. **32** And we are His witnesses to these things, and so also is the Holy Spirit whom God has given to those who obey Him.”

Our King

‘Archo’ - to rule, to begin, to be first

‘Ago’ – to bring, to lead, to command

- IE – “one that takes the lead or leads by example”
- “A PIONEER”

- Hebrews 2:**9-11**

9 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone. **10** For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to make **the captain** of their salvation perfect through sufferings. **11** For both He who sanctifies and those who are being sanctified are all of one, for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren

Our King

‘Nagid’ - a ‘leader, ruler, official, administrator’

- From root “to precede”
- go in front, go first, to go before
- To LEAD

Our King

- 2 Samuel 7:8-9

8 Now therefore, thus shall you say to My servant David, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts: "I took you from the sheepfold, from following the sheep, **to be ruler over My people, over Israel.**

9 And I have been with you wherever you have gone, and have cut off all your enemies from **before you**, and have made you a great name, like the name of the great men who are on the earth.

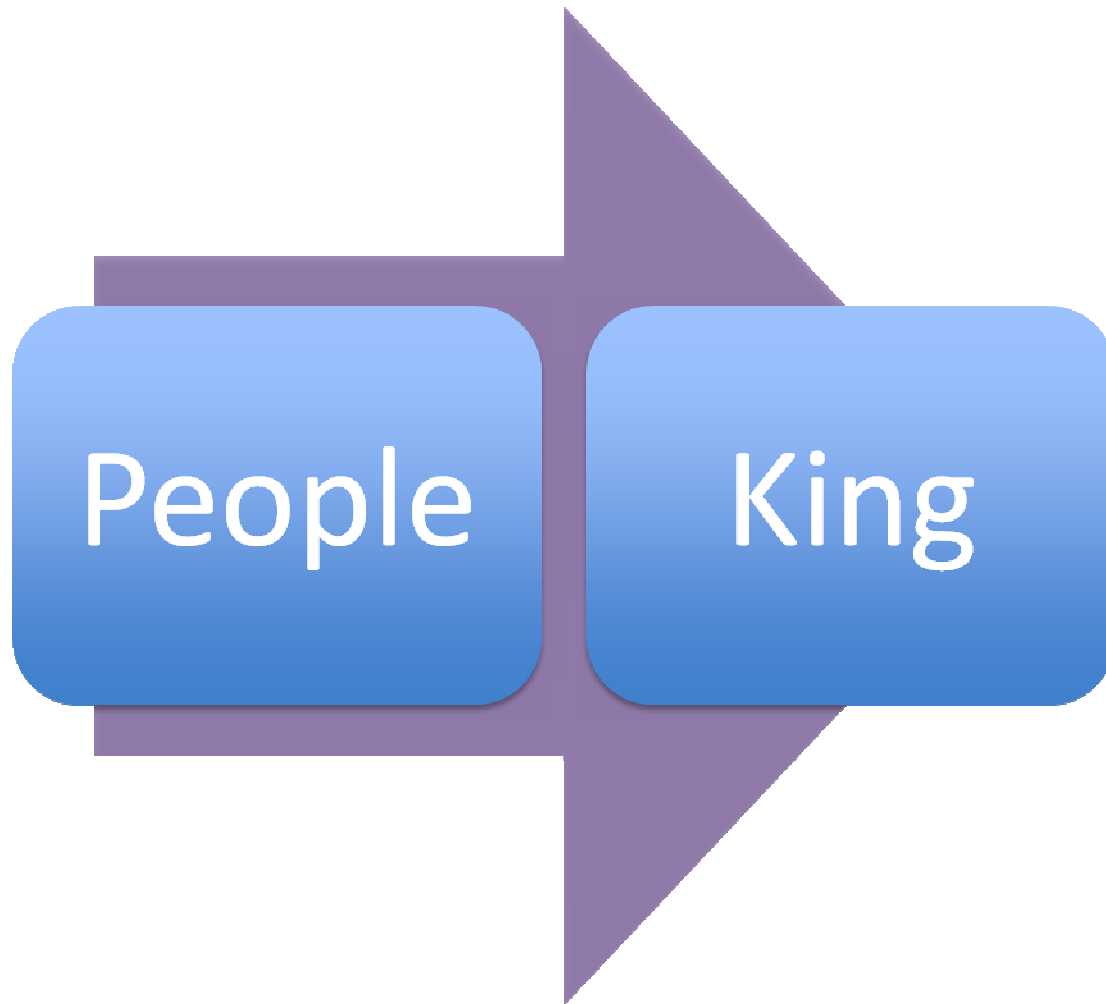
Our King

- **10** Moreover **I will** appoint a place for My people Israel, and will plant them, that they may dwell in a place of their own and move no more; nor shall the sons of wickedness oppress them anymore, as previously, **11** since the time that I commanded judges to be over My people Israel, and have caused you to rest from all your enemies. Also the LORD tells you that **He will** make **you** a house.
- **12** “When your days are fulfilled and you rest with your fathers, **I will** set up your seed after you, who will come from your body, and **I will** establish his kingdom.

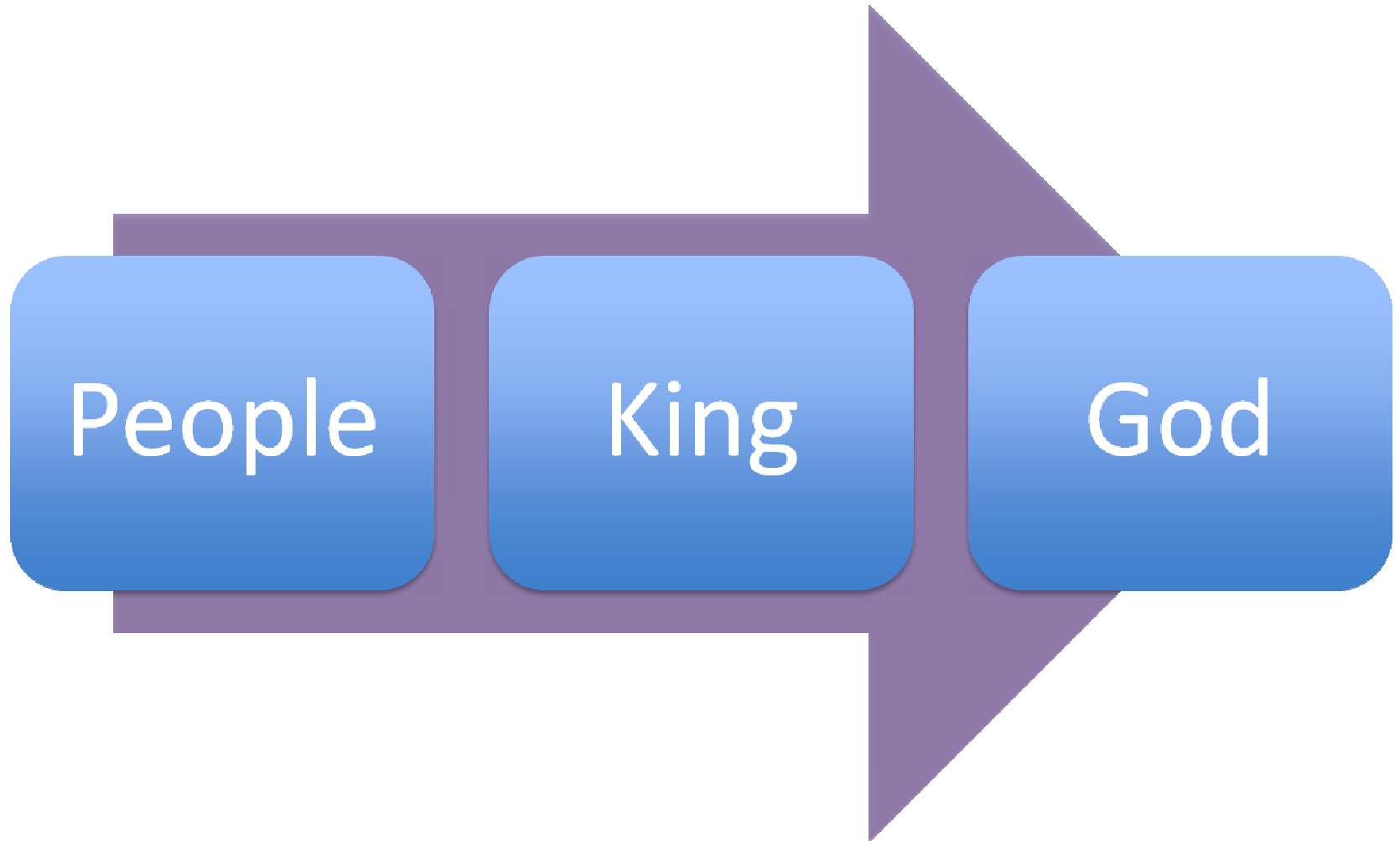
Our King

- **13** He shall build a house for My name, and **I will** establish the throne of his kingdom forever. **14 I will** be his Father, and he shall be My son. If he commits iniquity, **I will** chasten him with the rod of men and with the blows of the sons of men. **15** But My mercy shall not depart from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I removed from before you. **16** And your house and your kingdom shall be established forever before you. Your throne shall be established forever.”””
17 According to all these words and according to all this vision, so Nathan spoke to David.

New Testament

- ‘Hegemon’ – ‘leader’ or ‘chief’
Lexicon = Lit. “pride of place”
 - Pilate the GOVERNOR (Matt 27:2)
 - Felix the GOVERNOR (Acts 23:26)

New Testament

‘Archon’ - a ruler, prince, a leader or someone prominent in authority.

ie – someone who has a position of influence

- Matthew 9 – Jairus
- Luke 14:1 – the chief Pharisees
- Luke 23,24 – the chief priests and rulers
- John 3:1 – Nicodemus, a ruler...
- Acts 4:8 – the elders of Israel

New Testament

- ‘Archon’ - a ruler, prince, a leader or someone prominent in authority.

Used only by John – “the prince of this world”

- John 12:31
- John 14:30
- John 16:11
- IE – ‘Only Jesus has DIVINE AUTHORITY’

Revelation 1:4-5

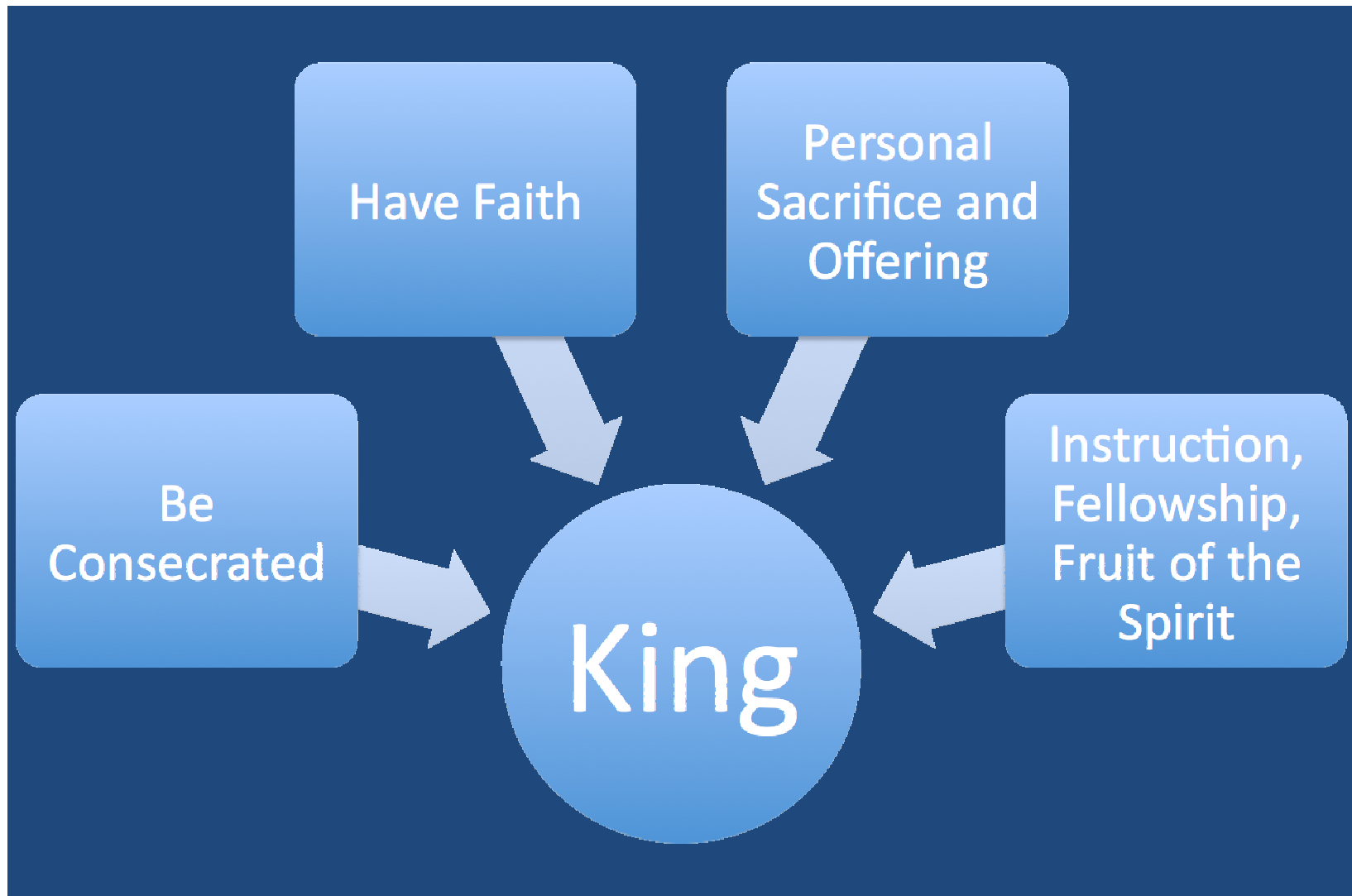

Colossians 1:18

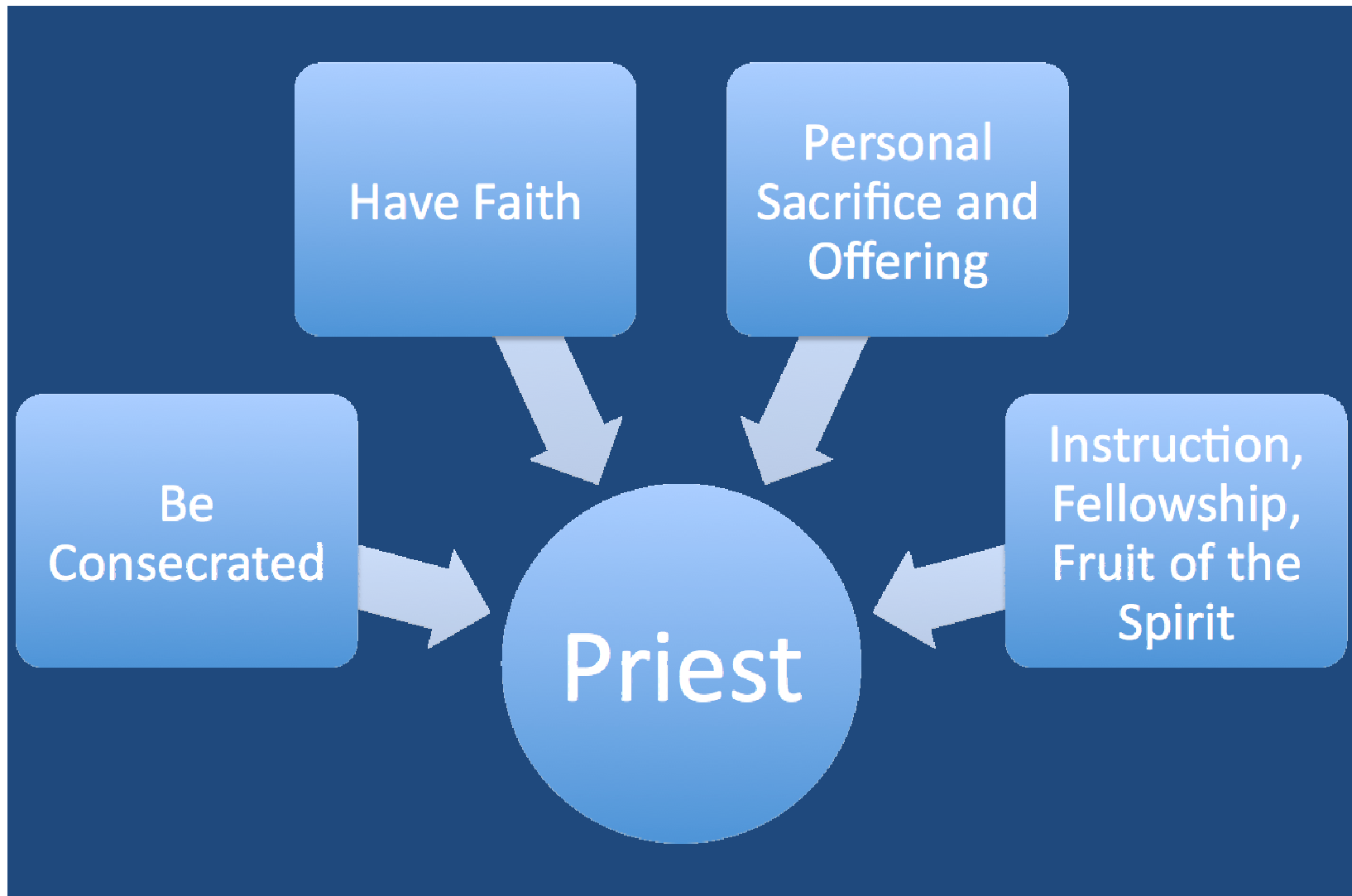

Kingship

- Man's way to kingship is through STRENGTH
