





THE OLD COVENANT

Had **no enabling force** to accompany it



Could **not provide** for the **permanent removal of sins**

HEB 9:9

... the gifts and sacrifices being offered were not able to clear the conscience of the worshipper.

HEB 9:9-10

Under the old system of which we've been speaking, all the gifts and sacrifices never really got to the heart of the matter; they couldn't assuage the conscience of the people; they were limited to matters of ritual. It was all essentially a temporary arrangement until a complete overhaul could be made.

ROM 7:12

... the law is holy, and the commandment is holy, righteous and good.

HEB 9:9-10

... the old system of (the law and everything associated with it) ... was all essentially <u>a temporary arrangement</u> <u>until a complete overhaul could be</u> <u>made</u> (NIV ... *"until the time of the new order"*)






