

#### **Enter The Preacher**

"The words of the Teacher, [Heb: Koheleth] son of David, king in Jerusalem" Ecc 1:1

Some debate the identity of the Preacher, but it is Solomon

"I, the Teacher, was king over Israel in Jerusalem." Ecc 1:12

No other son of David ruled Israel from Jerusalem

- the others ruled only Judah

## An older man with regrets

"Meaningless! Meaningless!" says the Teacher. "Utterly meaningless! Everything is meaningless." Ecc 1:2

I suggest this is Solomon, returning at last from the "mountains of myrrh"

### Solomon's Revelation



"Look," says the Teacher, "this is what I have discovered: adding one thing to another to discover the scheme of things- while I was still searching but not finding- I found one upright man among a thousand, but not one upright woman among them all." Ecc 7:27-28

Solomon chose 1 000 women - which nearly killed him

- => His comment is self-indictment!
- => Beginnings of recovery!

God gave Samson unique physical strength






### **The Giant Fell**

## **God Redeemed the Fallen**


Then the Philistines seized him, gouged out his eyes... But the hair on his head began to grow again after it had been shaved. Judg 16:21-22


God creates Supremacy The Physical Giant Judg 14:6,19; 15:14...

Sexual distractions precipitate collapse *Judg 14:2; 16:1,4...* 


God finds Redemption for the fallen Giant *Judg 16:22* 




Neither Physical nor Intellectual Supremacy lead to Salvation



Let not the wise boast of their wisdom or the strong boast of their strength. Jer 9:23






### **Jesus: The Most Alone**
