










CHRONOLOGICAL ORDER OF BOOKS







Isaiah 49:24-25 LXX

49:24: "Will any one take spoils from a giant? And if one should take a man captive unjustly, shall he be delivered?"
49:25: "For thus says the Lord: If one should take a giant captive, he will take spoils, and he who takes them from a mighty man will be delivered. For I will plead your cause, and I will deliver your children."
