Num. 1:45-46	So all the numbered men of the sons of Israel by their fathers' households, from twenty years old and upward, whoever was able to go out to war in Israel, even all the numbered men were 603,550 .		
Exod. 1:7-9	But the sons of Israel were fruitful and increased greatly, and multiplied, and became exceedingly mighty, so that the land was filled with them. Now a new king arose over Egypt, who did not know Joseph. He said to his people, "Behold, the people of the sons of Israel are more and mightier than we (or "too many and too mighty for us").		
Num. 26:51	These are those who were numbered of the sons of Israel, 601,730.		
Exod. 12:37	Now the sons of Israel journeyed from Rameses to Succoth, about six hundred thousand men on foot , aside from children . A mixed multitude also went up with them, along with flocks and herds, a very large number of livestock. See also Num 11:21 – "about 600,000 on foot"		
Exod. 38:25-26	Silver Collected = 301,775 shekels (603,550 X ½ shekel) = 300,000 + 1755 shekels = 100 talents (sockets) + 1755 shekels (hooks)		

The Firstborn

So Moses numbered all the firstborn among the sons of Israel, just as the LORD had
commanded him; and all the firstborn males by the number of names from a
month old and upward, for their numbered men were 22,273.

Number of males in Israel:	603,550
Number of firstborn males:	22,273
Average males per family:	603,550 / 22,273 = 27.1
Average children per family:	54.2!



Two Midwives

Exod. 1:15-17

Then the king of Egypt spoke to the Hebrew midwives, **one of whom was named Shiphrah and the other was named Puah**; and he said, "When you are helping the Hebrew women to give birth and see them upon the birthstool, if it is a son, then you shall put him to death; but if it is a daughter, then she shall live." But the midwives feared God, and did not do as the king of Egypt had commanded them, but let the boys live.

Deut 7:1	When the LORD your God brings you into the land where you are entering to possess it, and clears away many nations before you, the Hittites and the Girgashites and the Amorites and the Canaanites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites, seven nations greater (more numerous) and stronger than you.		
Deut. 7:7-8	The LORD did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any of the peoples, for you were the fewest of all peoples, but because the LORD loved you and kept the oath which He swore to your forefathers		
Deut. 7:17-19	"If you should say in your heart, ' These nations are greater than I ; how can I dispossess them?' you shall not be afraid of themSo shall the LORD your God do to all the peoples of whom you are afraid.		
Exod. 23:29-30	I will not drive them out before you in a single year, that the land may not become desolate and the beasts of the field become too numerous for you. I will drive them out before you little by little, until you become fruitful and take possession of the land.		
Num. 13:28-33	Nevertheless, the people who live in the land are strong , and the cities are fortified and very large ; and moreover, we saw the descendants of Anak there. Amalek is living in the land of the Negev and the Hittites and the Jebusites and the Amorites are living in the hill country, and the Canaanites are living by the sea and by the side of the Jordan we became like grasshoppers in our own sight , and so we were in their sight."		








- Judges 6:15 Behold, my family is the least in Manasseh, and I am the youngest in my father's house.
