



(23 AD to Present)




Ruling By Divine Right



Feast of Booths

"Then every one that survives of all the nations that have come against Jerusalem shall go up year after year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the feast of booths.

Feast of Booths

Seven days you shall present offerings by fire to the LORD; on the eighth day you shall hold a holy convocation and present an offering by fire to the LORD; it is a solemn assembly; you shall do no laborious work."

Feast of Ingathering

Lev. 23:39,40

The Purpose of the Feast

Lev. 23:41-44

"You shall keep it as a feast to the LORD seven days in the year; it is a statute for ever throughout your generations; you shall keep it in the seventh month.

You shall dwell in booths for seven days; all that are native in Israel shall dwell in booths, that your generations may know that I made the people of Israel dwell in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God."

Thus Moses declared to the people of Israel the appointed feasts of the LORD."



Dethroning of the Present Rulers

- ▶ Jesus will take matters into His own hand in a more direct manner than He has ever yet done.


Dethroning of the Present Rulers




Establishment of Jesus' government in each nation
