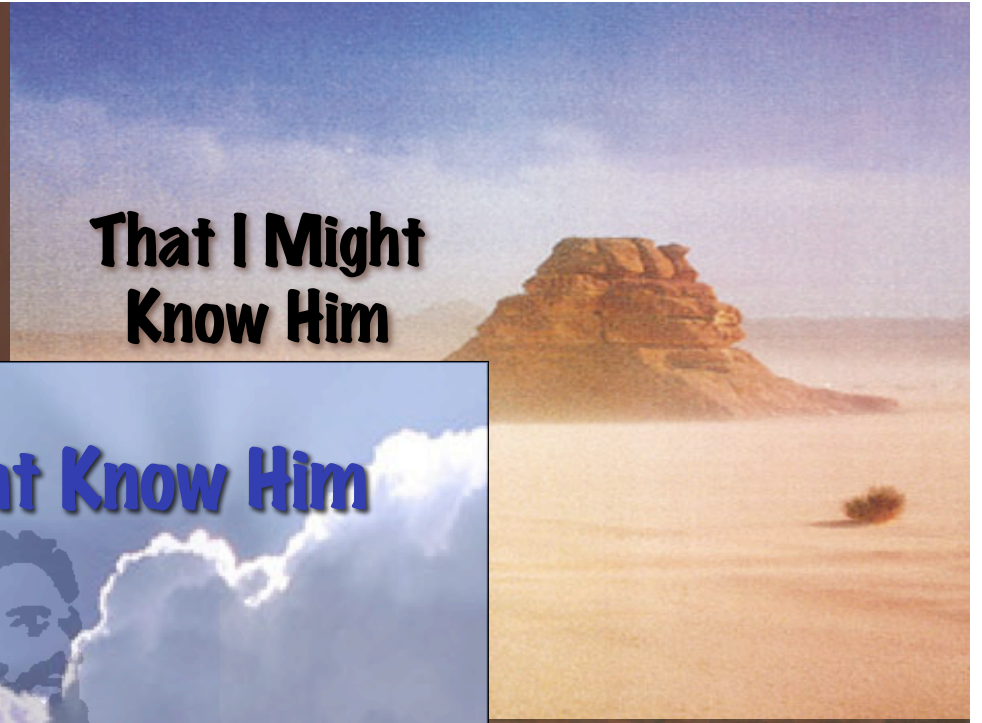

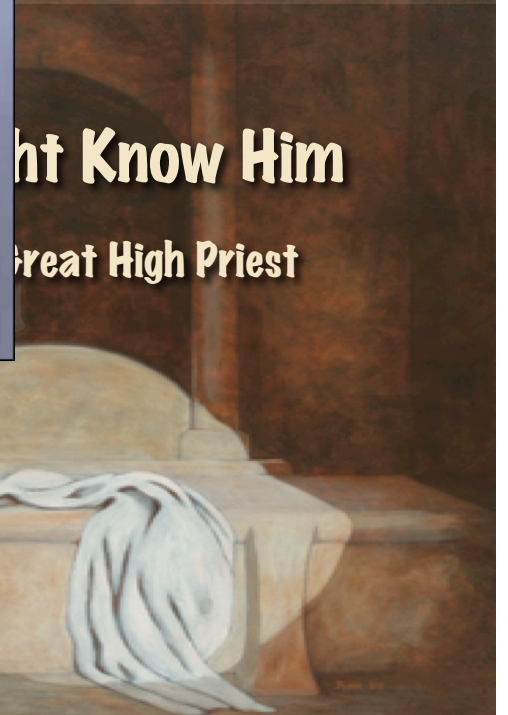

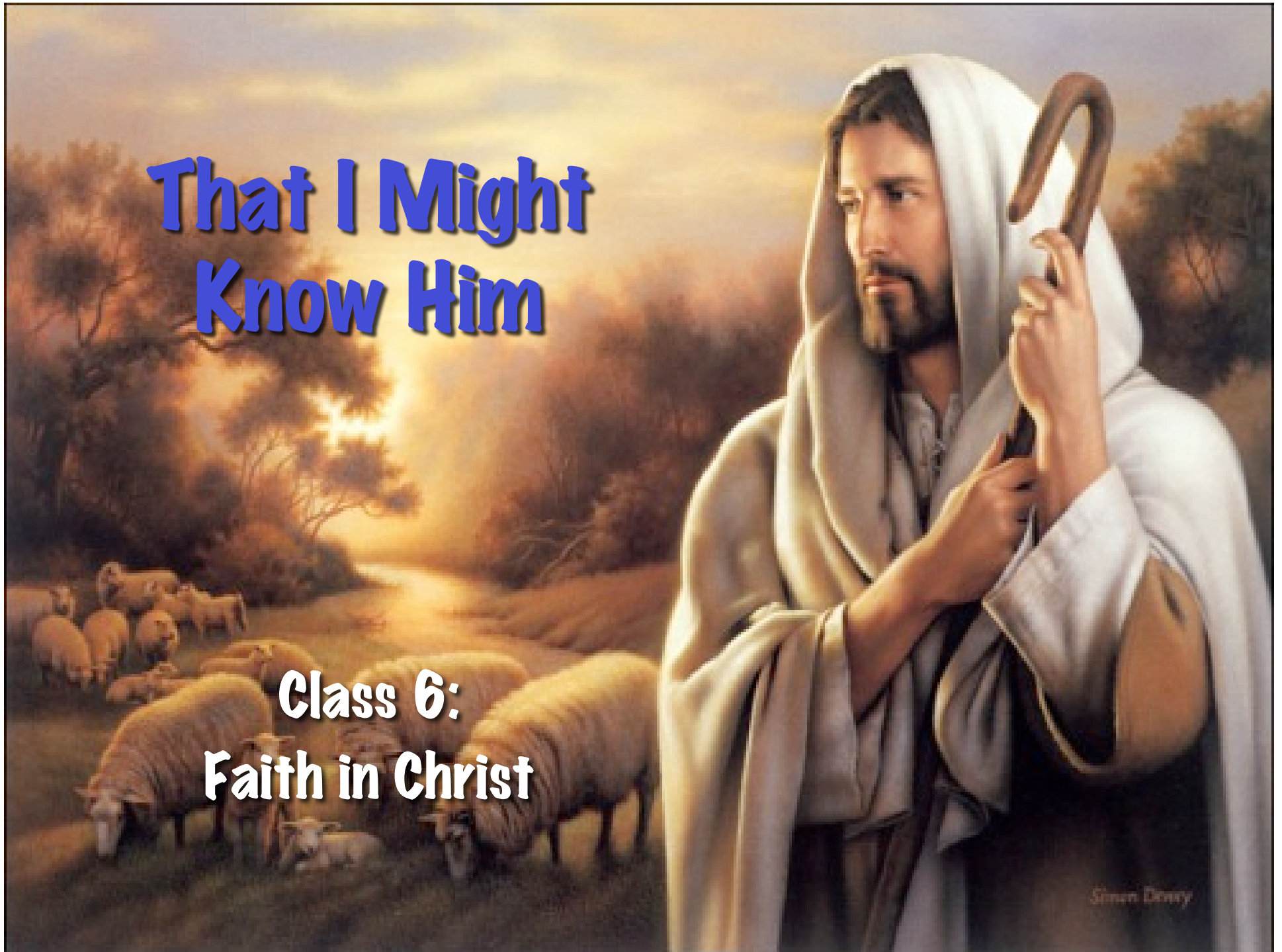

Faith in Christ?

We ourselves are Jews by birth and not Gentile sinners; yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through **faith in Jesus Christ**, so we also have **believed in Christ Jesus**, in order to be **justified by faith in Christ** and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified.

Gal. 2:15-16 (ESV)

Faith in Christ?

Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ and be found in him, **not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith.**

Faith in Christ as our High Priest

Faith in Christ as our High Priest

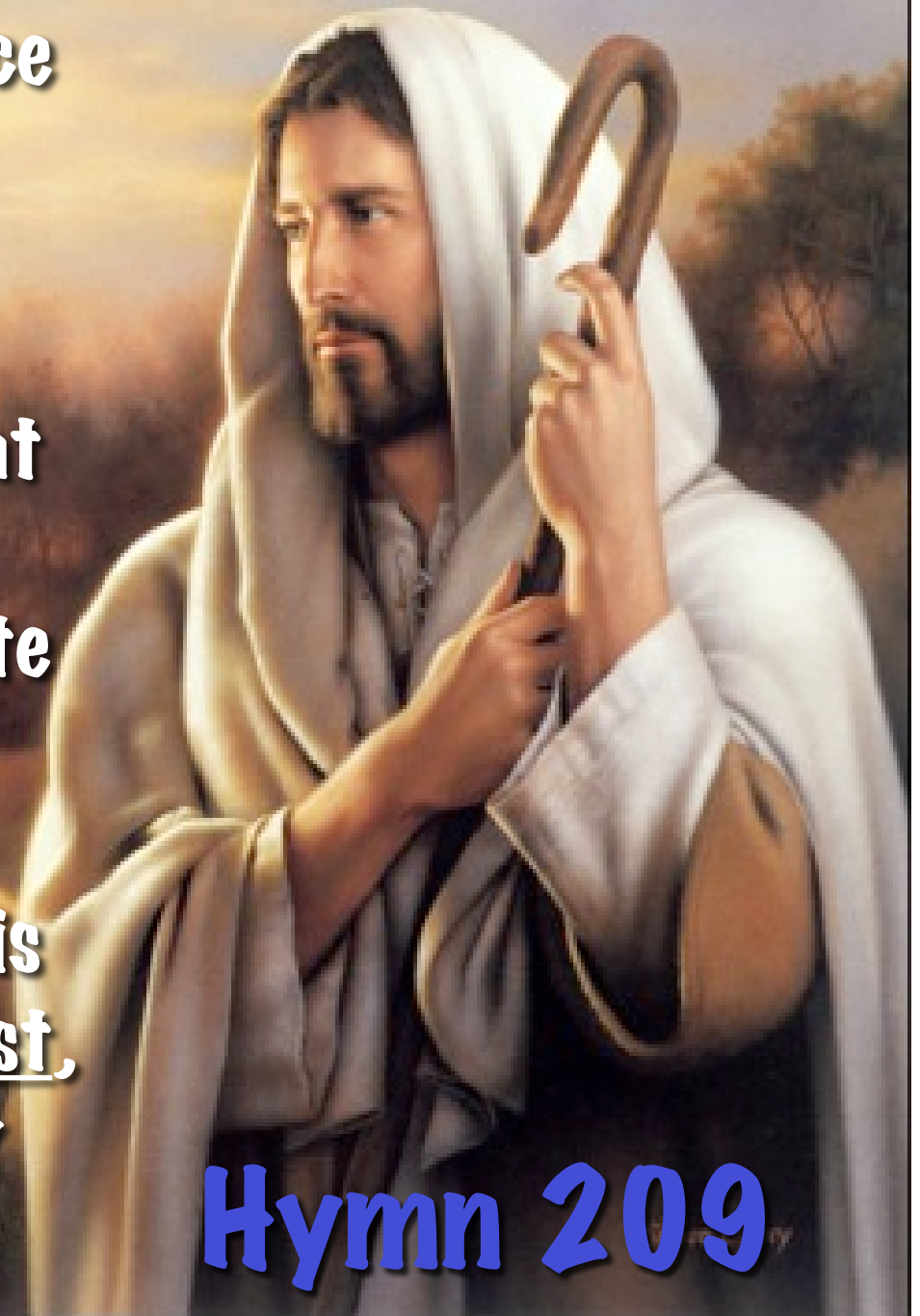
