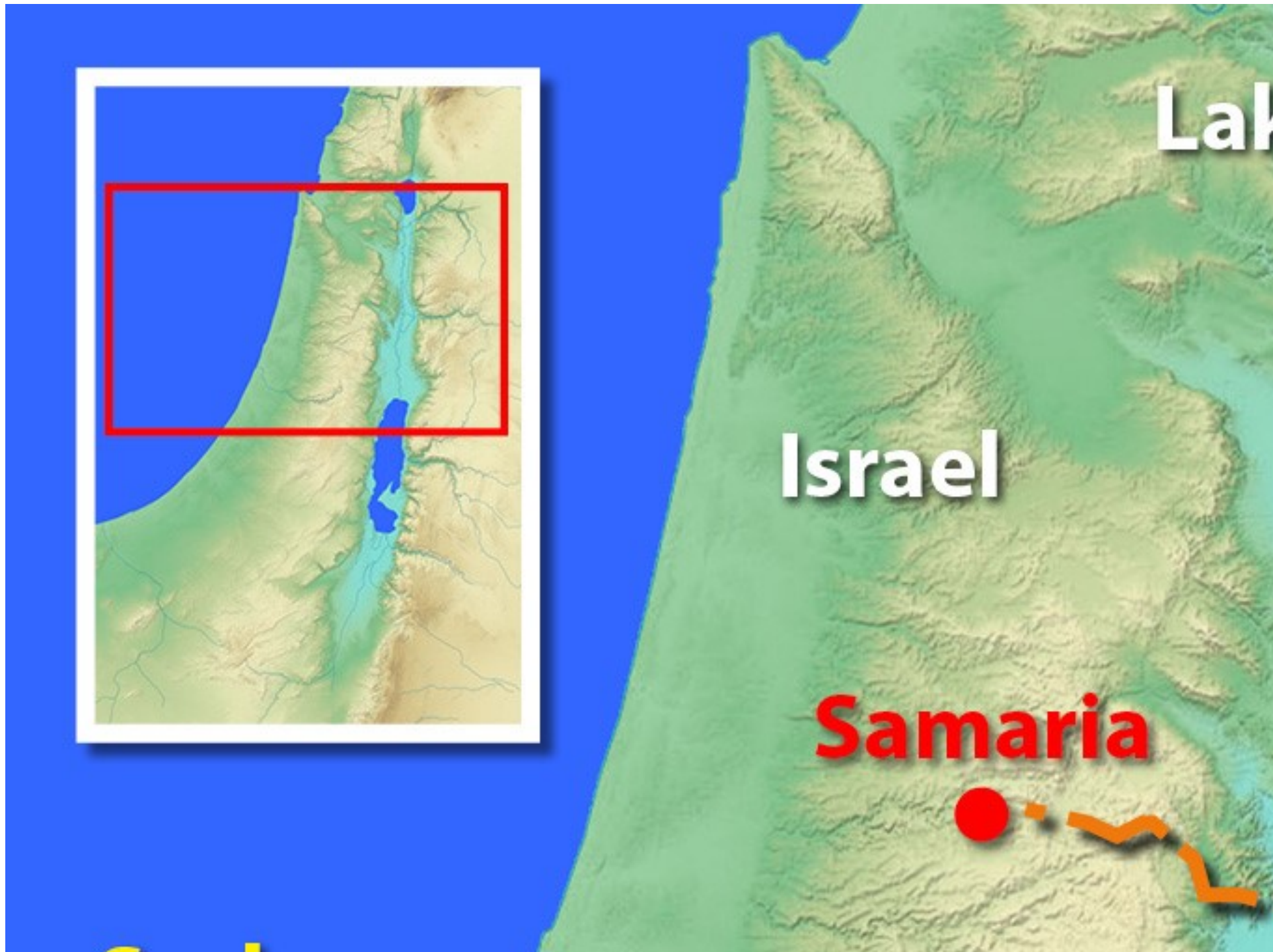


1 Kings 16 v 29-33

- ▣ v 30, 'And Ahab the son of Omri did evil in the sight of the LORD MORE than all that were before him.'
- ▣ v 33, 'And Ahab made an Asherah. Ahab did MORE to provoke the LORD, the God of Israel, to anger than ALL the kings of Israel who were before him.'

Deut 11 v 13-17

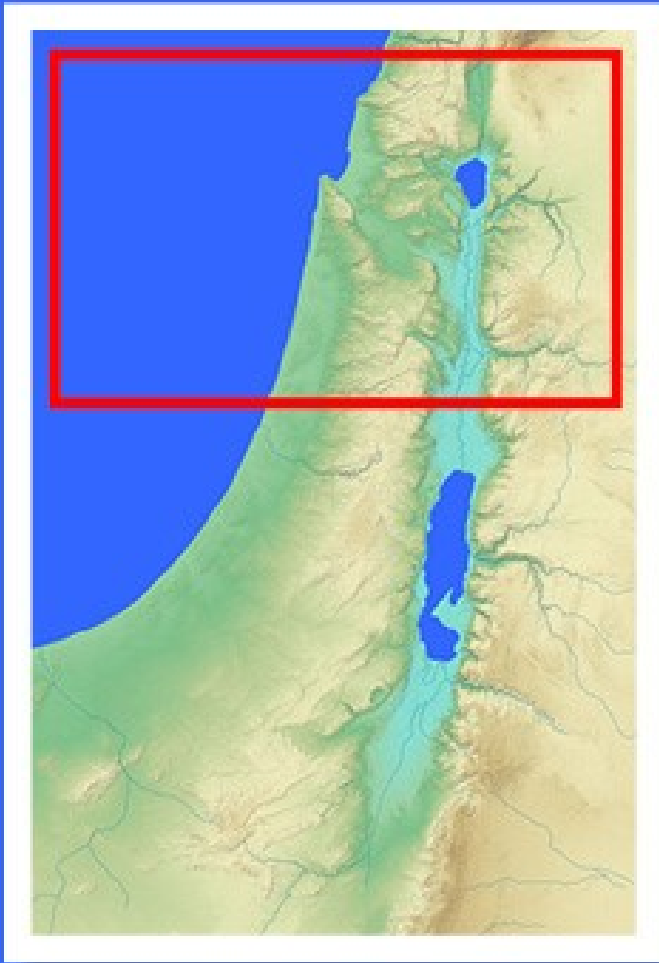
- ▣ v 16-17, 'Take heed lest your HEART be deceived, and you TURN aside and serve other gods and worship them, and the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and he shut up the heavens, so that there be no rain, and the land yield no fruit, and you perish quickly off the good land which the LORD gives you.'
- ▣ v 12, 'a land which the LORD your God cares for;'
- ▣ v 13, 'to LOVE the LORD your God, etc'





Ravens

- ▣ Job 38 v 41, 'Who provides for the raven its prey, when its young ones cry to God, and wander about for lack of food?'
- ▣ Lk 12 v 24, 'Consider the ravens; they neither sow nor reap, they have neither storehouse or barn, and yet God feeds them. Of how much more value are you than the birds!'
- ▣ Mt 6 v 33-34, 'O men of little faith?', 'Let the days own trouble be sufficient for the day'

Luke 4 v 25-26

- ▣ 'But in truth, I tell you, there were many widows in Israel in the days of Elijah, when the heaven was shut up three years and six months, when there was a great famine over all the land; and Elijah was sent to none of them but only to Zarephath, in the land of Sidon, to a woman who was a widow.'

Matthew 15 v 21-28

- ▣ v 21, 'And Jesus went away from there and withdrew to the district of Tyre and Sidon.'
- ▣ v 27, 'She said, 'Yes, Lord, yet even the dogs eat the crumbs that fall from their master's table.'
- ▣ v 28, 'Then Jesus answered her, 'O woman, great is your faith!'

WITHOUT MEASURE

- ▣ 15-16, 'And she went and DID as Elijah said; and she, and he, and her HOUSEHOLD ate for many days. The jar of meal was not spent, neither did the cruse of oil fail, according to the word of the LORD which he spoke by Elijah.'

WITHOUT MEASURE

- ▣ v 18, 'What have you against ME, O man of God? You have come to ME to bring MY sin to remembrance, and to cause the death of MY son!'

WITHOUT MEASURE

- ▣ v 24, 'Now I know that you are a man of God, and that the word in your mouth is truth.'
