

#### James 1


- 2 My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials,

11 Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.






















# 2 Kings 6

## Matthew 5

Greek – 'optanomai'

**Lexicon**: to gaze at (i.e. with wide-open eyes), as at something remarkable

## Key: open your eyes — and see the Lord

### Matthew 5

Greek - 'katharos'

**Lexicon**: purified by fire

"like a vine cleansed by pruning and so fitted to

bear fruit"

## Key: open your eyes — and see the Lord

#### Acts 7

"55 But he, being full of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God, 56 and said, "Look! I see the heavens opened and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God!"."

2) Greek – 'theored' **Lexicon**: to discern (literally or figuratively) to be a spectator of, look upon, perceive

## 2 Corinthians 1:3-4


3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, 4 who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.

#### Gk - paraklēsis;

- Console, solace, comfort.
- Intreaty, exhortation, adminition, encouragement.

#### Gk - parakaleō;

 To call near, i.e. invite, beseech, intreat, pray.

# Philippians 3:12-16

- 12 **Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on**, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me.
- 13 Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, 14 I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.
- 15 Therefore let us, as many as are mature, have this mind; and if in anything you think otherwise, **God will reveal even this to you**. 16 Nevertheless, to the degree that we have already attained, let us walk by the same rule, let us be of the same mind.
